## why

Climate crises necessitate a paradigm shift in the CO2-depleting construction sector. Emerging practices, both in theory and practice, show the potential of reuse at the levels of construction materials, building components or larger spatial configurations. Yet, these initiatives remain scarce and largely unknown.

This theoretical workshop seeks to map local networks of circular construction throughout Europe. We invite students and researchers to comparatively study local notions, practices and actors of availability-based construction. Case studies will be based in Greece, Liechtenstein, the Netherlands and Belgium.

This summer school consists of two parts: an online preparatory session and a workshop in Antwerp, Belgium. During the first, students will draw actornetworks and actions in their own cultural contexts. In Antwerp, we will explore the Belgian state of affairs through keynote lectures and multiple visits to local actors.
