





### **PROPOSED SITE**



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Originally a farmers settlement (along the main road), then a working class neighbourhood. Today is one of the most lively areas in Pavia in terms of grassroots initiatives and civic life.



### PROPOSED RESEARCH-BY-DESIGN METHODOLOGY

GIVEN:

30-year SCENARIO POST-CAPISTALIST, POST-HUMAN, ANTI-PATRIARCHAL SOCIETY CIRCULAR AND NON-EXPLOITATIVE PRODUCTION

3 thematic models of "alternative communities", entirely self-sufficient:

A) Agriculture-based (homo agricola - return to land, labour, new balance with natural and vegetal species)


- B) Multiculturalism-based (homo politicus integration, co-existence, hospitality, celebration of diversity)
