The project "Right to the City" (D@C) about knowledge and skills - theoretical, methodological, ethical, and professional - on the sustainable city for the 21st century, in compliance with UN SDGs. Quality of life is directly linked to the experience of spaces as a reflection of action between actors, mobility, and interaction, between knowledge (research and teaching), power (law and regulation) and experimentation (learning and application with the population) are fundamental.

The expected impact focuses on improving the knowledge and practices of the parties involved, which contributes to making the city, an equitable way, ensuring a permeability between academia, practitioners, and society, through the dissemination of contents and instruments that are supporting the development of a city co-created between actors, to provide answers to common primary needs and rights.

Target groups of the results of the consortium are understood to be all elements to whom the information may benefit (NGOs, Associations, authorities, etc.), resulting as benefit for the city and the people who live there, through the knowledge and practices that all sectors involved produce and/ or perform.

This consortium aims to consolidate citizenship, contribute to economic, social, and territorial cohesion, and enhance the competitiveness and attractiveness of the labour market. The connection between entities offers a greater possibility through networking and partnerships that allow a connection capable of enhancing a qualitative and quantitative advance for living conditions in cities.

MegaCities (Michael Glawogger, 1998, 90min)

Um olhar sobre as pessoas que vivem precariamente, mas com um nível incomum de desenvoltura e imaginação, em quatro aglomerações urbanas gigantescas: Mumbai, Nova York, Moscovo e Cidade do México.

Natura Urbana: The Brachen of Berlin (Matthew Gandy, 2017, 70min)

Documentário sobre a história pós-guerra de Berlim através de suas plantas. Uma viagem desde as ecologias únicas de Trümmerlandschaften, aos telhados abandonados do Friedrichshagen Waterworks, e à extraordinária variedade de vegetação espontânea de todo o mundo que brotou ao longo das linhas ferroviárias, nas esquinas e no distinto Brachen de Berlim.

Inside Out: The People's Art Project (Alastair Siddons, 2013, 70min)

Documentário sobre a evolução de um projeto artístico participativo. O premiado artista francês JR incentiva pessoas de diferentes comunidades a expressarem-se por meio de retratos em preto e branco e a fixar as suas obras nas ruas.

The Architecture of Violence (Ana Naomi de Sousa, 2014, 25min.)

Eyal Weizman explica o papel fundamental da arquitetura na ocupação israelita da Palestina e a evolução da guerra urbana.

Trilogia Qatsi: Koyaanisqatsi, Powaqqatsi e Naqoyqatsi (Godfrey Reggio, 1982, 1988, 2002)

Koyaanisqatsi: Uma coleção de fenômenos habilmente fotografados sem enredo convencional, com foco na natureza, na humanidade e na relação entre eles. Powaqqatsi: Uma exploração dos países tecnologicamente em desenvolvimento e o impacto da "modernização de estilo ocidental".

Naqoyqatsi: Um retrato do nosso mundo contemporâneo dominado pela globalização, tecnologia e violência.
