In a period when pedagogies are being reshaped according to new societal, economic, and technological conditions, schools more than ever are asked to play a crucial role for future generations. Also, when new programs are embedded in school's daily plans with afternoon activities and additional courses, we are in presence of spaces for education that have been thought on typological models based on rigid educational schemes – the typical disciplinary, front-desk, hierarchical education, the stark separation between teaching and play, a distribution scheme composed of corridors and classes, the secluded space of schoolyards.

The Erasmus + Blended Intensive Program NON-FORMAL SPACES OF EDUCATION. Reclaiming the School as a Space of Commons, aims to investigate the possibility of creating new educational spaces in already existing schools that can be obtained with the adaptation and transformation of an existing building and its surrounding space. Re-thinking an existing school means to investigate issues related to inclusivity and accessibility to everyone, fully integration of all societal groups, program to support learning disorders, active participation of community, sharing knowledge, caring, helping, and the role of play in education creating alternative and informal practices of appropriation thought learning.

How can we imagine new school spaces of inclusion that can establish new synergies among learning processes, empowering of communities, wellbeing, democratic participation, sustainable environment, and urban space?

How to arrive to Volos

Volos airport (http://www.thessalyairport.gr) is located at Nea Anchialos, 20 min distance by car/taxi from Volos, but it accommodates only a limited number of charter flights. Check at the airport link to find out more. You may fly to Athens or Thessaloniki Airport and then reach Volos by bus (Athens-Volos is 4h trip, while Thessaloniki-Volos is 2h15min) or train (Athens/Thessaloniki to Larissa and then Larissa-Volos by train/bus service). Volos Bus Station is located just close to the Polytechnic School where the Dept. of Architecture is based and few minutes walking to the city center.
