objective & description

The workshop Housing Project_Berlin Lab will be concerned with the rich architectural heritage of housing projects in Berlin formed by Gründerzeit, Modern Movement, post-WWII reconstruction, International Building Exhibitions (1957/1984), post-Wall regeneration and contemporary innovation and experimentation.

Participants act as urban investigators detecting best-practice housing projects and breaking down the respective information. They form project-teams in order to elaborate qualified descriptions of housing typologies and urban-development concepts as well as future strategies for new housing models.

The workshop will offer a platform for research & design collaboration to 35-40 students working in international teams formed during the preparative virtual phase.

methods & outcome

Lectures, panels, as well as site visits and urban investigations in combination with collective work at the drafting table will be the main activities of participants identifying and analysing collaboratively architectural heritage, contemporary examples and future strategies of housing development in Berlin. Possible case studies of excellent architectural practice and sustainable urban development have to be defined, respective representations to be worked out and prepared for exhibition and final review. Successful participation will be accredited with 3 ECTS.



BIP_virtual component 2.5.2025 - 12.6.2025 Starting from 2.5.2025 the BIP will be initialized by a preparative stage of online meetings (Webex) dedicated to the terms of reference and the assignment of specific tasks to be performed during the actual workshop in Berlin. A second stage of online-cooperation will be undertaken until 12.6.2025 concentrating on a finishing process with regard to the publication of the workshop results in academic media.
