# SELF COMMONS CONSTRUCTION - LOCI BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAMME (BIP) 2025

## **Project**

The intensive summer school "seLf cOmmons Construction" (LOCI) is an international workshop focused on commoning practices and experimental self-built architectural agencies set in Pavia. LOCI aims to explore innovative pedagogical methods and engagement processes by bringing students and citizens together in community-oriented design and construction.

The **virtual component** of LOCI is meant to set the theoretical basis for the project: it will include lectures by professors from partners' universities and by practitioners, preliminary design-focused discussions and brainstorming to outline the activities that will be carried out on site, and an online workshop with local stakeholders to allow a preliminary encounter and first data collection. The workshop aims to develop architectural interventions that support shared (commons-based) use of urban commons, involving the local community in participatory design and construction, fostering social engagement.

The workshop includes practical **self-building activities** and narration-based research, starting from a collaboration between organisers and locals to define the project theme. After a preliminary survey, the first day focus on community engagement through convivial situations. The co-design phase involves drawings as well as play and performative actions, alongside community presentations for approval. Construction, guided by a professional team of carpenters, allows participants to build the structures using locally found materials. The workshop concludes with an inauguration event. The different phases and aspects of the project (including the preparatory activities and the post-completion evaluation) will be documented and elaborated applying visual ethnographic methodology.

The programme recognises **4 CFU** for full attendance.
